Many of these families don't know where to go for information or support and can often suffer from high levels of stress and even depression.

Our Family Support Service helps families by providing practical and emotional support in the home, giving assistance in applying for statutory support and signposting to local and specialist support services.

As part of our Family Support Services we also provide Short Break Activities to enable disabled children to access fun, inspirational and accredited leisure activities. These activities not only build confidence and independence for each child but also enable parents and carers to have short break respite.
